



Sample Itinerary

Throughout each day, each student can assist our Fijian team with ongoing building and village maintenance projects which will be determined based on need and supply availability. In their downtime, students can get involved in tasks such as meal prep, fish catching/cleaning/prep, gardening, etc. Students can also apply their knowledge and skills to Fijian small business planning projects in ways such as basic accounting, logo/label design, and other ways as determined. There are no shortage of ways to keep busy in ways that benefit the island as a whole. In addition, during the morning community meeting each student is asked to sign up for duties that are needed to keep the village running smoothly. It is each student's responsibility to manage their time and complete their duties each day.
